ACCESSIBILITY

From the airport

Public Transport from Schiphol Airport: take the train to Rotterdam Centraal (Intercity Direct). Departs every 15 minutes and costs €14.70.

Public Transport from Rotterdam The Hague Airport: to Rotterdam Centraal take bus 33 - Metro E. Departs every 15 minutes and costs €2.21.

Take bus 50 and get off at the Meijersplein stop. There, enter the Meijersplein subway station and take the subway to the Wilhelminaplein stop. Exit the station and continue on the street Wilhelminakade; the hotel is approximately a two-minute walk.

Taxi from Schiphol Airport: Normally it's a 50 minutes trip of approximately € 150. **We have organized a special price of € 110 for EBOT delegates.** This price applies when calling after landing. An extra fee of € 25 applies if you prefer the driver to collect you with a name sign at the meeting point in the arrival hall.

Taxi from Rotterdam The Hague Airport: It's a 20 minutes trip and is around € 35.

From the train station

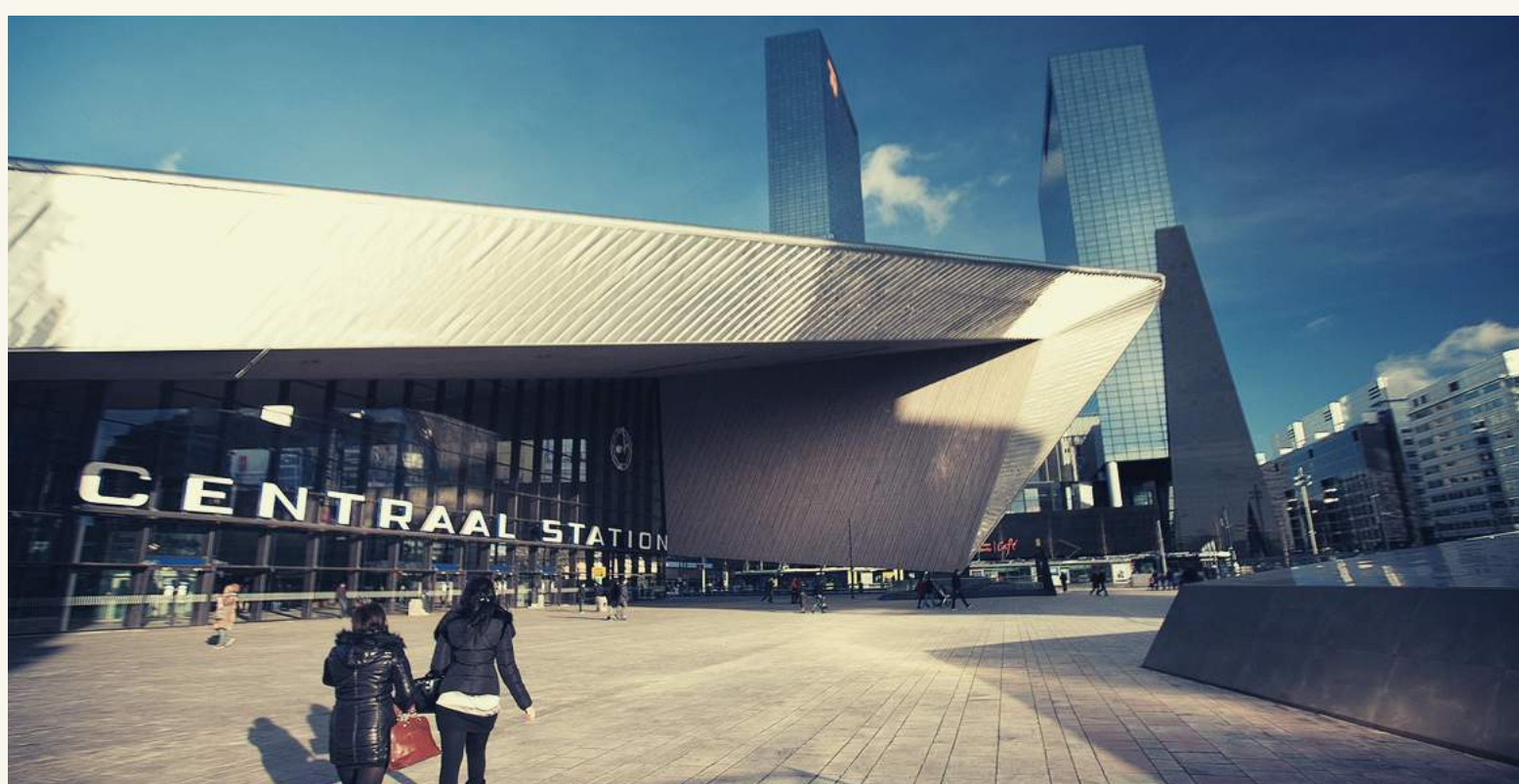
From Rotterdam Centraal train station: take subway line D/E towards De Akkers. Get off at the Wilhelmina station (3 stops / 10 minutes). Exit the station and continue on the street Wilhelminakade; the hotel is approximately a two-minute walk. It costs € 1.27.

Taxi from Rotterdam Centraal train station: It's a 15 minutes trip and is around € 20.

Stedelijk Museum Schiedam - Manzoni in Holland

Why use paint when there are so many other materials? So Piero Manzoni did the latter. In the sixties he made art with his breath, canned his own crap, autographed bodies and invited people to stand on a pedestal. On that magic plinth everyone became a work of art, a living sculpture. His revolutionary approach made him one of the great innovators of the 20th century and his can of crap became an icon of avant-garde art. Manzoni (1933-1963) died of a heart attack at the age of 30.



Jenever Museum - De Dutch Gin industry

Schiedam is renowned for its production of Jenever (gin). This production was the source of much of the wealth that built the city into what it is today. Step into the world of the Jenever industry!
